Located just north of Highway 58 and Main Street in Capron, VA/Southampton County is 23186 Main Street that sits on the corner.

Initial architectural style was a simple 2-story wood building built between 1900 and 1912. The building was bricked with traditional bricks approximately 30-40 years ago. Few modifications were made to the building. We believe that indoor plumbing and electrical work was done at that time.

The builders are unknown.

In May 2009, the property was donated to Mars Hill Baptist Church in Southampton County. It was around 2010 that the Turner-Allston Preservation, LLC purchased the property. Of note is that the property sitting on the corner and surrounding the Masonic Hall properties were, we believe, at one time connected.

In April 1705, the Virginia House of Burgesses designated two tracts of land known as the Circle and Square which was reserved as the domicile of the Nottoway Indians. Together the two tracts contained approximately forth thousand acres of land.

The three-mile Circle tract of the Reservation is located in what is now present-day Sussex County. The six-mile square was aligned on the west side of the Nottoway and extended to below present-day Capron, Virginia in Southampton County.

The parcels that are described in this Preliminary Information Form are located within the Square Tract in Capron, Virginia. The properties were once owned by known Nottoway Hezzie Smith who is the grandfather of our current Chief Lynette Allston. It was sold in the early 1900s to the Southampton Masonic Lodge No. 116, F. & A.M./Prince Hall Mason's Masonic Hall 116 (hereafter referred to as The Hall).

The Prince Hall Masons were formed because of racism and Jim Crow Laws. Persons of color were not welcome to join the masonic lodges that were formed by the white population. Therefore, it was common at that time for persons of color, whether black, native, etc. to see to their own means of education, economic growth, socialization, etc.

Included in this packet are minutes dating back to 1912 from the Minute Books of The Hall. Attachment 4.

At one time in history, The Hall was associated with the Odd-Fellows Lodge No. 10,002. Deeds found in Attachment 5AD, etc.

As well, included in this packet are photos of the building on all sides as well as the interior. The most recent renovations which took place around 2011 included upgrades to the plumbing, electrical lines, HVAC, cleaning and painting.

Masonic Lodge 106

My grandfather, Sidney Turner was a founding member of Capron Masonic Lodge 106. He was not only a founding member he also played a major part in the construction of the building which still stands today. My grandfather encouraged my father to become a Mason after coming of age.

My father Asphy Turner joined the Lodge after returning from WWII. He served as Treasurer up to retirement. As a member, his children were eligible for a Masonic Scholarship. My sister sat for a competitive test that earned her a scholarship which was a help to our family and our community.
